Dear City of Beacon City Council,

On Thursday, June 6, 2019 the Traffic Safety Committee received a message from Council person Nelson on behalf of a resident on Willow Street requesting that the Committee consider changing North Elm Street and Oak Street from a 3-way stop to a 4-way stop. Dutchess County Legislator Nick Page, who was present at the July 23, 2019 meeting of the Traffic Safety Committee also requested the Committee consider making the intersection a four-way stop.

The Traffic Safety Committee took the issue under consideration and received input from members who include representatives from both the Beacon Fire and Police Departments. After careful consideration, the Traffic Safety Committee has decided to recommend that the City Council adopt Proposed Local Law to Amend Chapter 211, Article II, Section 10 of the Code of the City of Beacon making the intersection of North Elm Street and Oak Street a four-way stop.
