RESOLUTION NO. 108 OF 2017

**CONFIRMING THE AWARD OF A CONTRACT FOR
THE LIQUID PHASE PRODUCT ODOR CONTROL SYSTEM AT THE WASTEWATER
TREATMENT PLANT PROJECT**

WHEREAS, on May 12, 2017 a Request for Bids was issued for the Liquid Phase Product Odor Control System at the City of Beacon Wastewater Treatment Plant Project; and

WHEREAS, one bid was received in response to the City's Request for Bids; and

WHEREAS, on May 31, 2017 the bid was opened and reviewed by consulting engineer Bipin Gandhi, P.E. of Lanc and Tully Engineering and Surveying, P.C.; and

WHEREAS, City staff and consultant believe awarding the contact to Evoqua Water Technologies, LLC to be in the best interest of the City of Beacon; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the bid for the Liquid Phase Product VX 456 Odor Control System at the City of Beacon Wastewater Treatment Plant Project be awarded to Evoqua Water Technologies, LLC, in the amount of \$1.07 per pound of solution which is approximately equal to \$11.45 per gallon; and

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Administrator of the City of Beacon is authorized to execute said Agreement and any documents consistent therewith.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the City Council of the City of Beacon authorizes entering into the Contract for Liquid Phase Product Odor Control System at the Wastewater Treatment Plant and the City Administrator is authorized to sign the Contract and take all actions necessary to implement its terms, subject to approval by the City Attorney as to form and substance of all such agreements.
