Award Recommendation

Dear Mr. Ruggiero:

A total of four (4) bid proposals were submitted and opened on July 13th, 2017 for the **South Interceptor Sewer Partial Replacement** project. The project entails the replacement of undersized 16" to 20" deteriorated sewer pipes along the South Interceptor, from the end of Simmons Lane through the Animal Rescue Foundation parcel, with new 30" sewer pipe and new sewer manholes.

The four proposals were carefully reviewed; all multiplication between estimated quantities and unit prices checked; and addition of total prices checked against the total contract amount. The proposal submitted was found to be complete.

The following tabulation shows the order from lowest bidder, the name of the bidder, and the total contract amount. The engineer's estimate for the installation of the new sewer main was approximately \$750,000.00.

The lowest bidder is Grant Street Construction, Inc., with the total base bid amount of \$752,927.00. Grant Street Construction has submitted information related to several projects in which they have completed the work as outlined within the proposed project. Grant Street Construction also worked for the City of Beacon previously for the replacement of the North Interceptor as it runs through the DIA parcel. References supplied were called and checked to verify the work completed by the prospective low bidder, and were found to be acceptable. In our opinion, Grant Street Construction, Inc. should be considered the lowest responsible bidder based upon the submitted information and Chapter 53 of the City Code. Along with the bid, the contractor has submitted a Non-Collusive Bidding Certificate, and a Bid Bond.

It is our recommendation to the City Council to award the **South**Interceptor Sewer Partial Replacement project to Grant Street Construction,
Inc.

CONFIRMING THE AWARD OF A CONTRACT FOR THE SOUTH INTERCEPTOR PARTIAL SEWER REPLACEMENT PROJECT

WHEREAS, on July 13, 2017 four bids were received and opened for the South Interceptor Sewer Replacement project; and

WHEREAS, City staff and Consulting Engineer John Russo, P.E. believe awarding the contract to Grant Street Construction, Inc. of Cortland, NY to be in the best interest of the City of Beacon; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the bid for the South Interceptor Partial Replacement project be awarded to Grant Street Construction, Inc. for the amount of \$752.927.00; and

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Administrator of the City of Beacon is authorized to execute said Agreement and any documents consistent therewith.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the City Council of the City of Beacon authorizes entering into the Contract for the South Interceptor Partial Sewer Replacement project and the City Administrator is authorized to sign the Contract and take all actions necessary to implement its terms, subject to approval by the City Attorney as to form and substance of all such agreements.
