WHEREAS, the City of Beacon City Council desires to allow electronic transmission of proposed local laws to members of the local legislative body; and

WHEREAS, N.Y. Mun. Home Rule Law § 20-4(c) permits municipalities to transmit the proposed local laws in Portable Document Form (PDF) electronically via e-mail to the inbox of a member of the legislative body provided that the e-mail address has been documented and published on the bulletin board of the local government clerk; and

WHEREAS, permitting electronic transmission of proposed local laws to members of local legislative bodies facilitates expedient and economical delivery; and

WHEREAS, the City of Beacon provides e-mail addresses to each member of City Council and has published such e-mail addresses on the bulletin board located in the vestibule of City Hall and the City's website; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Beacon hereby authorizes electronic delivery of proposed local laws to members of the local legislative body via transmission to their official municipal e-mail addresses.
